

Madison County Farm Bureau's 2018 County Fair Photo Contest
CONSERVATION AWARD

Photos in this category must be related to the conservation of our natural resources (soil, water, air, plants, animals). To be eligible, a **brief paragraph** describing the relationship of the subject of the photo to the topic of natural resources conservation **must accompany the photo submission**.

Conservation Category Prizes (co-sponsored by the Madison County Soil & Water Conservation District):

1st place = \$50

2nd place = \$35

3rd place = \$15

All other requirements for the Madison County Farm Bureau's 2018 County Fair Photo Contest apply:

- 1) Photo must be taken by exhibitor
- 2) Photo must be taken **in Madison County**
- 3) Photo must be taken from June 1, 2017 to June 30, 2018
- 4) Photo may be color or black & white
- 5) Photo may be processed from negatives, slides, or digital cameras and computer manipulation programs
- 6) **All photos must be matted on foam core board.** Photo must be a 5x7 with an 8x10 mat, or an 8x10 with 11x14 mat. **The photo mat and foam core board must be the same size, being flush on all edges.** No glass or picture frames will be accepted.
- 7) Entry form must be attached to the back of each photo.
- 8) Submissions are limited to one photo per class, per person.
- 9) Photo may be entered **only once in Farm Bureau photo contest**. Photo cannot be entered again in another year's contest. Same photo may be entered in 4-H or Open class exhibits.

Photos must be submitted to the Madison County Farm Bureau office at
115 W. Court Avenue in Winterset by **Wednesday, July 11, 2018** to be eligible for judging.
