**AMENDMENT OF SOIL LOSS LIMIT REGULATIONS**

Madison County Soil and Water Conservation District

Winterset, Iowa

Under the authority set forth in Chapter 161A, Code of Iowa, the commissioners of Madison County Soil and Water Conservation District, with the approval of the State Soil Conservation and Water Quality Committee, are required to adopt, amend, and repeal such reasonable regulations as are deemed necessary to establish and maintain soil loss limit regulations for the district and provide for the implementation of the regulations, and may subsequently amend or repeal their regulations as they deem necessary.

The soil loss limit regulations for the district are amended as follows:

1. Agricultural and Horticultural Land. Maximum rates of soil erosion for these lands will be the average annual soil loss expressed in tons per acre per year for each soil type in the district as shown on the attached revised list of soil loss limits.
2. Nonagricultural Lands. Including public parks, urban lands, industrial parks, airports, public and private recreation lands, roads, streets, highways, and other public lands. The maximum rates of erosion for these lands will be the average soil loss of 5 tons per acre per year leaving the site.
3. Construction Site. Including housing developments, shopping centers, industrial park developments, commercial building sites, highways, drainage channels, floodways, water impoundment structures, and other similar projects. Maximum rate of soil erosion permitted on such lands will be 5 tons per acre per year leaving the site.
