## Pasture Field Day on September 7

WINTERSET, IOWA, August 28, 2023 –

The Madison County Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD), Madison County Cattlemen’s Association, Iowa Forage and Grassland Council, and Iowa Beef Center invite the public to attend a Pasture Field Day on Thursday, September 7<sup>th</sup> starting at 5:00 p.m.
